Admission Criteria

EPHS is open to all students at the appropriate grade levels who are less than 19 years of age. EPHS is open to all students without regard for the place of residence of students or parents within California except for any limitation provided by law. When oversubscribed, admission to EPHS is determined by public random drawing with the application of the preferences given in the next section. The only admission requirement is that students wishing to attend EPHS must follow the school's admission procedures with respect to completing applications, and enrollment forms and documents by the announced deadlines. Application deadlines, are coordinated with local public and private schools to give students and their parents opportunity to consider the full range of educational opportunities available to them. Late applications for admission results in loss of admission and enrollment preferences as listed below. Late return of enrollment packets following notification of admission results in loss of place on the admission priority list discussed below.

There is no admission testing or other evaluation required of any applicant. EPHS does not charge an application fee nor does it charge tuition [California Education Code Section 47605(d)(1)]. EPHS encourages parent contributions to help fund EPHS's educational programs but does not require any monetary contribution as a condition for application, admission, enrollment, or participation in any of the school's required educational activities. EPHS is nonsectarian in its admission and enrollment policies and does not discriminate against any student on the basis of ethnicity, national origin, gender, or disability [Education Code Section 47605(d)(1)].

Enrollment Preferences

EPHS admits and enrolls all students who wish to attend the school provided that EPHS's capacity is not exceeded [California Education Code Section 47605(d)(2)(A)]. Classes at each grade level, beginning with the 10th grade and proceeding in descending order, are according to the following order of preferences for students who are either continuing enrollment or being admitted for the first time (listed in declining order of priority). [California Education Code Section 47605(d)(2)(B)]. The application of preferences will be further defined by Board policy.

1. Presently enrolled students who plan to continue attending the school
2. In-District students on the waiting list
3. In-District Everest student's siblings
4. Students residing within the boundaries of the District
5. Out-of-District students on the waiting list
6. Out-of-District Summit student's siblings
7. All other students who wish to attend the School

Admission Lottery and Admission Priority

When the number of students who wish to attend EPHS within each grade level exceeds the school's capacity, then the admission of new students is determined by a public random drawing for each grade level. [Education Code Section 47605(d)(2)(B)](Students with preferences are exempted from the lottery unless the number of students with preferences exceeds the capacity, in which case the lottery is held within the preference.) EPHS maintains an admission priority list on the order in which applicants to each grade level in each admission preference category were selected in the admission lottery. The order of admission of students at any time during a school year shall be based solely on the order of applicants on the admission priority list. EPHS maintains a list of students interested in transferring to the school. After the admission priority list has been exhausted, the school will advertise if a space has become available. If more applicants than spaces are available, another lottery will be conducted for the open spaces.
